



**Sponsorship by APCD for Attending
2nd Asia-Pacific CBR Congress
in Manila, the Philippines,
29 November – 1 December 2011**



Background:

The Asia-Pacific Development Center on Disability (APCD) plans to sponsor former APCD Training participants. In conjunction with the 2nd Asia-Pacific Community-Based Rehabilitation (CBR) Congress which will be organized from 29 November to 1 December 2011 in Manila, the Philippines. APCD has issued a call for good practices and lessons learned that link Community-based Rehabilitation (CBR) and Community-based Inclusive Development (CBID). We are seeking good examples of CBR initiatives across the disability and development sector in Asia and the Pacific that promotes positive changes in each community.

Objectives:

- 1) To identify good practices of CBR by former APCD CBR training participants
- 2) To provide the opportunity on presentation of the good practices at 2nd Asia-Pacific CBR Congress

Eligibility (1 and/or 2):

- 1) Former APCD training participants, particularly training courses on Community-Based Rehabilitation (CBR), Self-help Group (SHG) and Disability Gender and Development (DGD).
- 2) Persons with disabilities and other CBR practitioners currently being engaged in APCD's Focal Points and Associate Organizations.

Submission:

- 1) The abstract paper should be sent by 2 May (Mon) 2011.
- 2) The abstract paper must indicate i) information and knowledge relevant to the topics and sessions of the 2nd Asia-Pacific CBR Congress and ii) outcomes after training at APCD, including impacts to the CBR projects and/or organizations.
- 3) The result of abstract screening by APCD will be informed to all applicants by 30 June (Thu) 2011.

Sponsorship

1) APCD will support participation of the selected former APCD training participants who may present the good practices on CBR in the 2nd Asia-Pacific CBR Congress in Manila, the Philippines from 29 November (Tue) to 1 December (Thu) 2011 on these following items:

- 1.1 oversea transportation
- 1.2 accommodation in Manila
- 1.3 registration fee

- 2) The selected CBR good practices will be publicized to potentially prove valuable for addressing future CBR perspectives.
- 3) The selected participants will be requested to submit report on participation of 2nd Asia-Pacific CBR Congress by 16 December (Fri) 2011.
